1. Who was James Blake of Knights Enham who left his will in 1734?

Finding this will for James Blake of Knights Enham written 3 Jan 1727 and probated 8 Jul 1734 was an interesting read. He was not actually living at Enham but was living at St George Bloomsbury Parish in Middlesex. His widow Jane (daughter of Sir Edward Hungerford) renounced the executorship of the will for herself and her six daughters Elizabeth, Diana, Jane, Rachel, Anne and Sarah. Although I found the will very interesting I did not pursue the information around the will at that time but decided that I would do so in this issue. This will has four margin insets with one of the insets mentioning that the original indenture tripartite mentioned therein was between John Blake and others. One of the four insets was at the top of the page.

Although I had planned to work on the Somerset subsidies for this issue and the Blake names listed therein, time escaped me and it will have to happen at a later time. As I mulled that around I thought about that rather interesting will and decided to work on that over Christmas time for publication on New Years Day. Having transcribed the Parish Registers for Knights Enham which do not begin very early, 1683 Baptisms, 1697 Marriages and 1693 Burials, the large Blake families there in the 1500s and 1600s are sadly missing although recorded in Wills so reproducible in spite of that loss.

There were also quite a number of Briefs (monetary collections for tragedies both in Britain and in the world) but the Blake entries were all Mrs. Blake so not identifiable.

All of this information is from the Fiche for Knights Enham PR1, PR2, PR3, PR4, PR6, PR10, PR11, PR12, PR13, PR14, PR15. The list that I received from the Hampshire Record Office included only these Parish Registers back in 2005 when I purchased them. It is likely that I specified a particular time frame but I have forgotten. The website for Hampshire Archives lists: Knights Enham: St Michael – Baptisms 1683-1994, Marriages 1697-2003 and Burials 1693-1992 (marriage gaps to 1814). The Bishop's Transcripts do not commence until 1780.



A search on Find My Past for Blake at Knights Enham yields 5,067 results with no time frame listed. Adding a time frame from 1540 +/- 40 years yields 134 results from 1546 to the 1600s which is a generous addition to the 1580 specified but I am content with the results. The last page and two entries on the second last page are from the Phillimore Marriage Registers in the area around Knights Enham (Penton Mewsey and Hurstbourne Tarrant). Looking at the nine pages of results there are not any actual results for Knights Enham (including name variants for the surnames which yields 148 results but again no Knights Enham entries).

Searching the Hampshire Archives with James Blake Knights Enham as key words located five items.



Following the will of James Blake there is a large chart of the many wills for the Blake family at Knights Enham and in the area around from 1521 to 1734 (James Blake's will) but missing from that list is a will for Edward Blake and Richard Blake sons of Joane Blake mentioned in the property documents above (they do not appear to have left a will). A Joane Blake (daughter of Sir Edward Hungerford), widow (mentioned in the document above), leaves a will probated 28 Feb 1675 naming sons Edward, Robert and Richard, daughters Joane Frampton, Mary Snatt. Joane (grandmother of James Blake) was married to Robert Blake of Enham and he was the second son of Thomas Blake and Eleanor Hall. I do not find a will for this Robert Blake. Their son Edward married Abigail Hayes and they were the parents of James Blake who left his will which was probated in 1734.


In as much as the son of Diana, Princess of Wales is next in line to the throne of the United Kingdom this family of Thomas Blake and Eleanor Hall becomes most interesting in that the Earl of Spencer's line traces back to this Thomas Blake of Knights Enham. I think it will be the first time that a Blake line has become part of the royal family tree. The tracing of the Spencer family tree was published by Richard K. Evans, 2007 and published by the New England Historic Genealogical Society at Boston, Massachusetts, USA – The Ancestry of Diana Princess of Wales for Twelve Generations. It is a fascinating read collecting up names from all over England (and the United States of America) that eventually channel down to Earl Spencer and his children. Thomas Blake is the 12<sup>th</sup> generation and #5532: "Thomas Blake of Easton Town, Hampshire, born ca. 1562 and buried at St Pauls Church, Convent Garden, near London 19 Aug 1660". He married, #5533, "Eleanor Hall, of Bradford, Wiltshire, perhaps buried at St Paul's Church 3 Nov. 1668" (page 295). The Blake Pedigree Chart does list John Blake and Margaret Blake as the parents of this Thomas (he was their eldest son). The Pedigree Chart does link John back to William Blake and Avice Ripley listing them as his parents. But it also mentions that Margaret is the daughter of William Blake of Estontown aforesaid. I believe that this John is the eldest son of William Blake and Elizabeth of Eastontown but there is a possibility that this William was married twice and I have not yet seen any evidence of that. The William Blake in this chart married to Avis Ripley does not appear to have an ancestry proven by wills and I do not know who he is although the chart has him as the son of Roger Blake who left a will but only mentioned his eldest son and youngest daughter. 
William Blake who left his will in 1582 though is William the son of Nicholas Blake. William would likely have been born at Old Hall, Knights Enham but he lived most of his life at Eastontown after adulthood as far as I can determine. Although William (will probated 1582) does have a daughter Margaret she married an unknown Jarvis and since he is recording this in 1582 it adds further proof to this thought. I believe that Margaret is the daughter of William Blake and Avis Ripley if such a marriage occurred and is perhaps descendant of the Calne Blake family as shown in the chart with John being descendant of the Knights Enham Andover Blake family. As far as I can tell this is the only slight error in the chart thus far located by me. Although I do have queries about some of the other information from this earlier time period I have not particularly followed them up although the subsidies of Somerset would also involve this Pedigree Chart.


I have enlarged some of the portions from the Blake Pedigree Chart below which is available for purchase from the Swindon and Wiltshire Record Office. I have opted not to reproduce the one section that I believe to be in error at this time. Reprinting small errors can have an enormous impact in subsequent years so I do avoid doing so although do mention what is in the chart.











The property at Enham does appear to move about the Blake family and does not remain long in the Robert Blake line it would appear (son of Nicholas Blake) unless both Robert and Nicholas shared this property and for whatever reason it actually ends up with the second son of Thomas Blake and Eleanor Hall namely Robert Blake. My own line was at Eastontown where Richard was born (circa late 1550s) and Richard as an adult was then a Draper in Andover. Interesting that my line would remember that they were descendant of Nicholas Blake of Old Hall (which is at Knights Enham although no longer exists). It was said by my Grandfather to me that the Blake family of John Blake (his grandfather) used to go to Knights Enham once a year to visit Old Hall (which was apparently a pile of rubble (my great grandfather Edward Blake was born in

1845) when Edward visited it). My grandfather was also there several times I believe as moving about became easier as the years passed. Later after he died my father mentioned Old Hall once as the place where his furtherest back ancestor known to him at that time (perhaps ten years after my grandfather died (1953) actually (I married in 1966 and then moved away in 1976 from the area my parents lived in)) was Nicholas Blake of Old Hall. An interesting look at the Blake family of Knights Enham who have pretty much lived their lives quietly in the Andover area for the most part until the end of the 1800s except for the line of Thomas Blake and Eleanor Hall which moved to Surrey and then London although there may yet be surprises for some of these lines – the pursuit has only just begun and I am unlikely to be the one who finishes it; I leave that for other descendants to pursue their fascinating ancestors when I have laid down my pen.



More and more material becomes available as times passes and for each of us that means that the work we do will be carried on.

At this time I am still contemplating doing Y-700 on my brother's sample and my next step will be to check and see if there is sufficient sample to perform that test. I seem to be slow at completing this task but perhaps this winter I will speed up as my life comes together somewhat more this year.

One new member of the group has ancestry from Cornwall, UK which is quite interesting. He does not have a clear match with other groups and I have postulated that the Cornwall Blake family is from Breton France arriving in England in the 1400s-1500s. This has not been well received by descendants in Cornwall. I have not pushed it very much and will let the future take care of that. One must remember that the UK was covered in literally tons of ice during the last glacial maximum so no one was there 8,000 to 12,000 years ago likely. We, and my lines are all included, had to move to England/British Isles from somewhere else.

#### 3. Andover, Hampshire, England, Parish Registers - Baptisms

Andover, Hampshire, England has often been said to be the "home of the Blakes" when I have been writing to people in Hampshire through the years. I would say that Calne, Wiltshire perhaps has a stronger hold on that particular title although there are a number of other areas in England where the Blake family has been for centuries. When I decided to transcribe the Parish Registers of Andover I was surprised to find that yes there are a number of Blake entries but there are far more Blake entries in Parish Registers in other parts of England as mentioned. In this issue, I will publish the baptisms for Blake in the Parish Registers. These records are taken from fiche which have scans of the original parish registers. The registers for baptisms begin in 1588 and have provided me with a lot of details on the Blake family in Andover in the late 1500s and into the 1600s/1700s. Eventually I hope to complete my project of transcribing these Parish Registers for St Marys Andover beyond the early to mid 1700s.

Baptismal Registers commenced in 1588 and I will start publishing these transcriptions for Andover.
