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1. **Guest Article: Are the Blake of Swaffham and Wimbotsham/Hampton NY Related by William R Blake, Part 1**

Before answering this question I want to extend my thanks to a number of people. First goes to Bill Bleak, Elizabeth Kipp, and Susan Osborne for all of their great work on the Blake Surname Project. Next I want to thank Jean Timmons Blake for the detailed work she puts into her managed profiles on Wikitree, and Linda Hurtubise who was very prompt to an inquiry I sent to her. To all of the Blake researchers out there posting to Ancestry, Wikitree, Geni.com, Family Search, Rootsweb, etc. Finally but not least to the late Carleton E. Blake, author of Descendants of Jasper Blake *Emigrant from England to Hampton, N. H. Ca 1643 1649-1979*.

The towns of Swaffham and Wimbotsham are approximately 21 miles apart and are located in the county of Norfolk, UK. Norfolk is located in what was the ancient kingdom of East Anglia.

In the following there are four Thomas Blake associated with the Swaffham Blakes, two Peter Blakes associated with the Wimbotsham Blakes, a John Blake in Swaffham and a Sir John Blake in Wimbotsham. Thomas Blake born approximately 1382 will be Thomas Sr, Thomas born approximately 1405 will be Thomas Jr, Thomas Blake dying about 1505 will be Thomas III, and Thomas Blake named in will of Thomas Blake III will be Thomas IV. Peter Blake b circa 1440 died after 21 Oct 1500 will be identified as Peter Sr. Peter Blake born circa 1466 to 1470 died circa 1500 will be identified as Peter Jr. John Blake in Swaffham will be John of Swaffham, John Blake of Wimbotsham will be Sir John Blake

During my 40 years of military and federal government service I was taught to give the bottom line up front. In keeping with that I believe the answer to the title question is YES.

Why do I believe they are related?

The first answer we have to this question can be found on Page 13 of Carlton E. Blake's book. Here he describes the Coats of Arms for the two families as recorded in Burke's General Armory. He notes a similarity which indicates a family relationship.

On page 11 of his book, Carleton Blake ends his pedigree for Jasper Blake the Emigrant at Peter Blake born in Southeney and in 1466 as the purchaser of the Manor Tonwalls located in Wimbotsham (in Norfolk, England). Researchers posting to Rootsweb, Geni.com and FamilySearch give his birth as 1440 to 1443 and death at 1500. They also extend his ancestry back to Thomas Blake of Swaffham born ca 1382 died ca 1439. Using this information we can surmise the following family tree around October 1500. How is Jasper Blake (1500-1547) related to Peter Blake (1440-1500)?

Peter Blake Sr’s will dated October 21, 1500 and proved about 25 Nov 1500 shows us the following family relationship from those named in his will. Peter Blake Jr is not named in the will. The only named spouse is Peter’s wife, Elizabeth. Peter does not name his parents or any siblings. He does name a nephew and niece.

Blake Family from Peter Blake Sr’s Will

In her wikitree profile for Jasper Blake 1500-1547 (Wikitree ID Blake-4250), Jean (Blake) Timmons states that Jasper is most likely an orphan but somehow related to Peter Sr and his wife Elizabeth. Some other Jasper Blake researchers posit that he is a nephew of Peter Sr or Elizabeth. I believe he is the grandson of Peter Sr and Elizabeth, as shown in Carleton

Blake's book, and that his parents were Peter Jr and possibly Elizabeth Spilman. I also believe that Jasper's father and most likely his mother were dead at the time Peter Sr had his will prepared.

Carlton Blake, and researchers posting to Rootsweb, and [geni.com](https://www.geni.com) all show Peter Sr and Elizabeth having children identified as Peter, John and Mary (dates of birth vary). Peter Sr's will only lists John and Mary as children, he also identifies Thomas Blake Esquire as a nephew and Elizabeth Blake as a niece. He does not identify how Jasper is related but the wording of his will gives a very important clue: "...to have and enjoy the said manor to him and his heirs male;". This phrase indicates that Peter Sr was willing Tonwells to Jasper in perpetuity once Jasper reached 22 years of age under the Common Law practice of Primogeniture Inheritance in use at the time of his will.

[brewminate.com](https://www.brewminate.com) "The Law of Inheritance in Medieval England" states that the rules of Law inheritance or Primogeniture were largely settled by the 13th century. Under primogeniture inheritance precedence went initially to the deceased person's issue with men being favored over women. Only the oldest male child inherited the family landholdings even if he had older sisters or other younger brothers. If there were no male heirs, females would share equally. If any children of the maker of the will should be deceased but have surviving issue, then that deceased child would be 'represented' by his/her issue. "Thus, the (oldest) son of (a person's) deceased eldest son had priority over (that person's) younger sons...". This was in practice in all of England except Kent.

With Jasper being named as the inheritor in perpetuity ("to him and his heirs male") of the Manor Tonwells and its associated lands indicates that he is the eldest son of Peter Sr's eldest son, who has predeceased Peter Sr. Jasper is not the son of any of the named individuals in Peter Sr's will because they would be the responsible party for his Rule and Keeping/Governance and Peter Sr would not have had to lay this out in his will. If he was a nephew, under the common law of primogeniture, he would not take priority over Peter Sr's son John, which he clearly does in the will. Therefore, Peter Jr must be Jasper's father and Peter Sr's eldest son. Based on this we can refine the family tree above as follows:

Refined Wimbotsham Blake Family Tree

I give Sir John's birth year as 1472 because in Peter Sr's will he inherits land and is named as a future ward for Jasper. In addition Peter Sr does not lay out any wardship for Sir John. All of this indicates that he is at least 21 years of age (age of majority for males at the time). Mary's birth year range is also correct because no wardship is indicated for her, indicating that she is at least 14 years of age (age of majority for females at the time). Sir John is also identified as being the Clerk of Swaffham. Sources are:

At this point wardship for Jasper becomes an issue. At the time of Peter Sr's will, per [NationalArchives.gov/Uk/help_with_your_research/research_guides/land-inheritance-court-of-wards-liveries-1540-1645](https://www.nationalarchives.gov.uk/help_with_your_research/research_guides/land-inheritance-court-of-wards-liveries-1540-1645), the Crown would assume wardship of any land being inherited by an underaged person without a surviving father. The Crown would then usually sell the wardship to either next of kin or other men in favor with the Crown. The Crown retained only the most lucrative lands. The Crown or the purchaser would then be entitled to the income the land generated until the devisee of the land reached majority. At that time, the devisee would then have to sue for the release of the liverie and pay a fee to get title to the land. In many cases there would be further litigations for the devisee to recover damages created by the purchaser of the land wardship. The land wardship fell under the auspices of the Court of Wards and Liveries. Even though the Crown had a land wardship it did not usually take a wardship of the person, this was usually the responsibility of the family. In many cases, as well, the land wardship purchaser would be responsible for arranging the marriage of the devisee most often to a child or family member of the land wardship purchaser.

Peter Sr's will spells out Jasper's wardship of the person by naming his wife, Elizabeth, then his son, Sir John, then his nephew, Thomas, and finally William Skypwith Esq as having responsibility for Rule and Keeping/Governance of Jasper. His will is also using a practice in use at the time to avoid the Crown taking wardship of the land called "cestui gue use" per [Brewminate.com](https://www.brewminate.com). What he is doing he is gifting the Manor Tonwells first to his wife for the term of her life, then son Sir John for the term of his life and finally Nephew Thomas for the term of his life with the idea that one of them will live long enough to be able to transfer the Manor Tonwells to Jasper upon his 22nd birthday. It turns out that all three of them died around 1505-1507 and the land must have gone under Crown wardship as there was a Court of Wards and Liveries Post Morten Inquiry in January 1547-48 after Jasper's death. Evidently there were no issues as the land remained in the family for at least four more generations.

2. Robert Blake who left his will dated 1521 at Enham – some new thoughts

Charlou Dolan's chart of the descendants of Robert Blake (I believe to be the eldest son of Richard and Jone Blake) and his six sons is an excellent collection of material. I continue looking at Enham (where this Robert lived) although the last Newsletter looked at James Blake who left his will in the early 1700s at Knights Enham (I think they are basically the same place just short-formed in those early days). More and more material becomes available as times passes and for each of us that means that the work we do will be carried on perhaps modified slightly but the bulk of the work remains with each project to be added to by those in the now present and into the future. I will bring the article on James Blake and this discussion on Robert Blake at Enham in the early 1500s together eventually.

Since Charlou Dolan's work comes forward from Robert Blake (who left his will in 1542) we will actually begin with a Robert Blake who left his will in 1521 as a likely elderly individual who names his adult son Richard in his will along with other Blake individuals both related and where the relationship is unknown (list below).

The testator Robert Blake has sons Thomas and Richard and he writes his will 16 Dec 1522. He lives at Enham. He mentioned Andrew Blake, William Blake and Robert Blake not noting any relationship. The will of Richard Blayke was written 12 Apr 1522. He appears to be giving a ring to his sister (unnamed) although this particular line is difficult to transcribe.

Having Richard as an adult son gives a certain age to Robert, the testator. He does not mention grandchildren but his son Richard is the possible husband of Joan who left her will in 1527 and named her children Robert, Nicholas and Elizabeth (Blake) Mylne. Richard leaves his will in 1522 and Thomas 1541. Written in English at the bottom of Robert's Latin will he says that he gives to his son Richard the farm and tenement that he is living in which must be in Enham as it is the only place mentioned. Since he is giving his farm to Richard I am left to assume that Richard is the eldest and he is also named executor with Thomas witness which tends to let me think that Thomas is the youngest and he is to inherit Rawkins in Enham.

Interestingly though there is a mention of a Robert Blake in the will. Who is this individual? The translation of this section which mentions a Robert Blake (line 15 – 16):

I give and bequeath to Robert Blayke one cow and the remainder of all my good goods and my testament of movables and immovables.

One thought that comes to me that Richard is the eldest son; just not referred to in that way. Thomas, by referring to him as “Tome filio meo” gives him a somewhat youthful/youngest son look. Richard is his executor which also leads one to think of him as the eldest. The other thought though is Robert Blake also mentioned in the will. Is he Richard's son (i.e. grandson to Robert the testator, the giving of a cow along with all of his does make one wonder about that). Plus the entire translation of this section includes “I give and bequeath to Richard my son whom I order my true executors to be”

and is he including Robert as one of the executors? Richard's will is written in April of 1522 so was perhaps ill at the time his father wrote his will in December 1521. Richard does mention his son Robert in his will and he is the eldest. I believe he also mentions Nicholas but only as Nichi and his daughter is mentioned but not by name.

I have read these wills through many many times and used a latin translator to try to understand them as written. But I believe that I was missing in Robert's will the idea that Robert and Richard being named as executors might mean something along with the cow and all of Robert the testator's good moveable and unmoveable being given to Robert on such a personal note. This may help to link these wills together even moreso – the will of Robert in 1521, the will of Richard in 1522 and the will of Jone (likely wife of Richard) in 1527. All wills written in Enham. Richard does mention his brother is Thomas another link between the will of Robert and Richard. I found the latin in Richard's will less able to understand as it does not always seem as clear as that of his father but I am only slowly learning Latin.

This now allows me to move to Robert Blake of Enham who left his will in 1542 (son of Richard and grandson of Robert). I now feel that the proof is sufficient to link these three men together.

Charlou Dolan has done a rather lengthy review of available material on the family of this Robert Blake so I would only refer one to her work and a blog which I published a while ago (we are not in entire agreement but one must judge for oneself), I have a number of times written about Richard Blake who left his will in 1622 (living in Andover) and I believe to be a son of William Blake (who left his will in 1582 (at Eastontown near Andover):

I am still left with a William Blake and an Andrew Blake in Robert Blake's will and how do they fit into the Blake family in

Andover or are they living at Andover? Robert gives and bequeaths to Andrew Blake one tenement (is he a younger brother to Robert?) was my first thought. To William Blake, Robert gives a cow. These two references do not follow one after the other but this man is elderly and possibly jumping from thought to thought (as I approach my 80s I do notice that my thoughts are not quite as didactic as they once were!). It would make sense that this is a child that is close to Robert as he has given him a cow so could it be a son of Andrew. We do not see the name of Andrew again in the Blake family coming down; at least I do not recall one in this family. But there is a relationship between the Blake family in Speen Berkshire and Andover Hampshire. The relationship is unknown but a will for a William Blake of Speen probated 1552 and written in 1552. This William mentions William Blake (son of Nicholas who was the son of Richard son of Robert) at Knights Enham at that time. An interesting thought I must carry through on one of these days.

3. Manager for the Blake family of East Anglia

I am William R. "Bill" Blake and I just volunteered to be the group admin for the East Anglia Blakes. I can now trace my Blake lineage all the way back to Thomas Blake of Swaffham 1382-1439. I was born and grew up in the heart of the California Gold Rush area in the early 1950s and spent 41 years (26 in the Army and 15 as a senior level IT and Resource Manager) serving our nation. My wife and I now live in Las Vegas, NV about 15 miles north of the famous or infamous Strip.

My father got me interested in Genealogy in the mid 1980s when he asked if I could help him find information on two distant cousins who, according to family lore, served and died at Gettysburg. I discovered that they did not serve at Gettysburg but in the Mississippi Campaign and one died at Vicksburg. The other survived and after the war moved to Kansas and then Texas. This effort gave me incentive to learn more about my Blake family tree. Listening to my mother talk about being related to Mayflower passengers also made me interested in her family as well. Unfortunately, this was a huge rabbit hole. Maybe more on that later.

As I got more interested in Genealogy, I also got interested in how DNA could help match us with other family members and cousins. I took an ancestry.com autosomal DNA test about 8 years ago and now have about 40,000 cousin matches (31,000 Maternal and 19,000 Paternal) with only 4 matching on both sides. I recently took the FamilyTreeDNA Big-Y test and also got re-interested in the Blake Surname Project (first learned of it when I took the Ancestry test). For anyone interested in seeing what type of test results are received you can google my confirmed haplogroup (see test kit number 989699 in the table on the web site) and look at the DNA story and other items available. I plan to also take a mtDNA test to learn about my mother's genetic line back to mt Eve.

Looking forward to being of help to the Blake Surname Project and my thanks to all of the hard work put in by Bill Bleak, Elizabeth Kipp, Susan Osborne and all of the other Blake family researchers around the world.

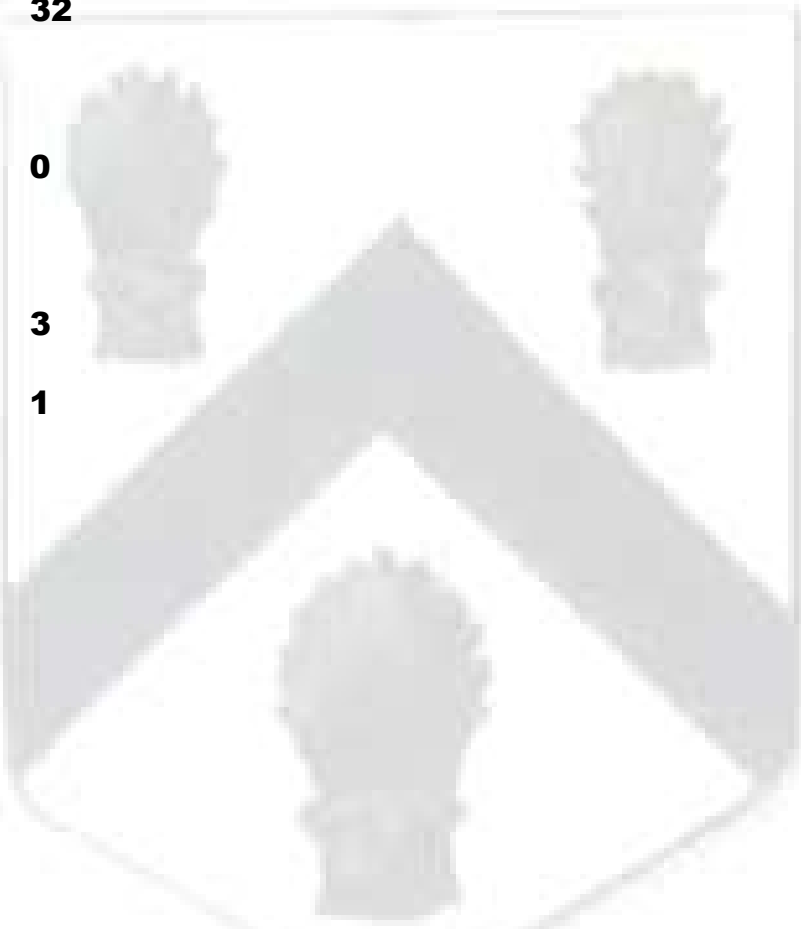

In actual fact, the individual groups really only need to work together as they share common ancestry known to them. The notes page is open within the study so that members can correspond with each other readily. I do not often read this section so do feel free to write to me at my email address (bottom of each newsletter) if you have a comment, article or suggestion.

5. Andover, Hampshire, England, Parish Registers - Baptisms

Andover, Hampshire, England has often been said to be the “home of the Blakes” when I have been writing to people in Hampshire through the years. I would say that Calne, Wiltshire perhaps has a stronger hold on that particular title although there are a number of other areas in England where the Blake family has been for centuries. When I decided to transcribe the Parish Registers of Andover I was surprised to find that yes there are a number of Blake entries but there are far more Blake entries in Parish Registers in other parts of England as mentioned. In this issue, I will publish the baptisms for Blake in the Parish Registers. These records are taken from fiche which have scans of the original parish registers. The registers for baptisms begin in 1588 and have provided me with a lot of details on the Blake family in Andover in the late 1500s and into the 1600s/1700s. Eventually I hope to complete my project of transcribing these Parish Registers for St Marys Andover beyond the early to mid 1700s.

Baptismal Registers commenced in 1588 and I will start publishing these transcriptions for Andover.
