I have continued with my extraction of DNA data and Ancestry has been the latest to undergo my combing through the matches. I have completed looking at Blake matches (191) in my test and I am now working on the second sibling of four tested there. I am creating a database showing the Most Recent Common Ancestor between the match and the sibling and there have been a surprising number going back to our 3x great grandfather Thomas Blake. I had marked them but never really thought about how to make use of that information but the book will be more complete if I bring the lines forward into Census time in England commencing on a family level with the 1841 census although I will actually bring everything forward probably to the 1861 census is my thought at this moment in time. The census is available on a number of databases making this a practical way for people to use what I have written and look back at their own families if they so choose.

I have also been debating with myself just how widely this book would circulate and I have pretty much made the decision that the original complete book will sit with the Guild of One-Name Studies (I am member #4600 studying

BLAKE and PINCOMBE) and they have their rules for access. I will publish a less inclusive book with a Creative Commons License and that will be available for download from my website (as with the other books it will be freely circulated). I will also send copies to other repositories that are used by many genealogists. The logic in not publishing the entire book is mainly because I do not feel that there is a huge benefit other than from a historical point of view which is best dealt with in an academic environment and at this point in my life (80 years of age) I do not see myself going back to school for any reason as I have too much that I want to do in these years ahead of me as many as there may be which is unknown to us for sure. Hence I would not feel that I had academically challenged the book sufficiently to publish it in its full form but will place it as I said with the Guild and they have their own rules for use and distribution which I feel are very academically sound.

I completed the extraction of information from Living DNA and did find that quite interesting with regard to Blake and families associated with Blake. There are a number of founding Blake families in the British Isles and for the most part the Andover Blake Family has a number of matches which are quite interesting to me but I actually did not write to any of them nor do I plan to do that. The book will not come down to the present time period; not even close actually as it may not list my own grandfather who was born in 1875 at Upper Clatford son of Edward Blake and Maria Jane (Knight) Blake who married at Upper Clatford in 1870. Samuel George Blake was their third child, the first being Louisa Mary followed by John and then my grandfather and another nine children were born to this couple. Only two male grandsons were born to this couple in the Blake line (my father and his cousin Edward who died in WWII (shot down over France (near Marseilles) on a reconnaissance mission 18 Jun 1940). I have four brothers (and two sisters) but none of my brothers had sons so this yDNA line from Edward Blake (son of John, son of Thomas, son of Joseph etc) ends with our generation. However Edward was the youngest son and had four older brothers who did have male descendants. One more generation back and Thomas Blake had five sons and four of them survived to adulthood and have left families which included male descendants. But I did decide that the yDNA result should be in the various databases and accessible plus I have given the information to several universities in England looking for such data.

The database from Ancestry will likely take me another month to complete and along with that I have begun the rephasing of my grandparents and would like to give the phasing of my great grandparents an attempt as I have a lot of

matches that do go back readily to the great grandparents due to endogamy in particular in my Knight-Butt-Arnold-Ellis lines and my Routledge lines thus covering some of both my paternal and maternal ancestors. To a certain extent Blake is also showing endogamy on occasion but the marriage of cousins in that case is many many generations back to the 1500s. I think most endogamy is in the Knight line of my great grandmother Maria Jane (Knight) Blake married to Edward Blake. Ancestry has also made a rather interesting conjecture based on the public tree (lacking information on my paternal grandmother's paternal line) to which I attached myself and my siblings for use by Ancestry in predicting ancestors with the TruLines project has interestingly chosen the Cotterill family which I have in the past hypothesized to be the line of my paternal grandmother for quite a number of matches. The difficulty with that was ascertaining whether the DNA matches showing Cotterill was from an earlier marriage between Mary Rawlins and Stephen Cotterell (his brother William was the ancestor of the family suggested by Ancestry) and Mary was the daughter of my 5x great grandfather William Rawlins and Mary (Foord) Rawlins and they lived at Enford. This line moved to Australia (Cotterell/Rawlins) and the matches with their descendants were surprisingly at the top end of likely amounts of centimorgans so I could not be sure that a match was not picking up this more ancient known match. But ancestry has done so and it is rather interesting. I did not add in parents for my paternal grandmother on the tree so Ancestry did it for me. Interesting really. Perhaps I should now say that he is the likely father of my grandmother. Certainly her adopted father was very important to her and it wasn't until I recalled many years later my father said to me one day that he had three grandfathers (a gardener (his mother's stepfather), an agricultural worker (my great grandfather worked on the local farm), and a farm bailiff) which for some reason cemented itself into my brain way back in the 1960s. My parents wanted a 60<sup>th</sup> anniversary book for their wedding anniversary and they asked my husband to write it. He said he would and I did all that research at the Family History Library back in the 1980s since they are my parents and I could understand that they wanted this book. I searched and searched for my paternal grandmother by the name that had always been used by her but was unsuccessful. I asked my mother and father whether there was a different spelling for her name but they said not to worry about it and just do the rest so I did.

However I was finally drawn into genealogy in 2003 as my 4<sup>th</sup> cousin George DeKay wanted a profile of my Pincombe family for the Westminster and Delaware Township History Books. That is a long story and will omit as I have repeated it many times but the long and the short is that I took it on for him and it was published and I suddenly realized that

someone has to do the genealogical work of a family in order for it to be in place for anyone in the future to pick it up and run with it once again. I decided it would be me which is amazing as I had managed to stay away from it for the most part all through Edward's dedicated research on his families from the time I first knew him. I always looked things up for him when we went on our many trips to repositories way back in the 60s and the 70s until our first child was born really although when the children were old enough they joined in on the trail to be with their Dad. His research was pretty much all colonial American but after I took the courses in UK genealogy research I helped him to get back into those very early records of his family lines (all Dissenters pretty much!).

One of the early lessons was to find your grandparents birth/baptism, I signed up with the National Institute for Genealogical Studies in 2003 to get it right as this was all English (UK) research my father was born there along with all of his families, my mother's families consisted of just two people born in Canada (her father and his mother; my mother was also born in Canada as was I) and all the rest were from England and I had two years to write it. Well there was all the methodology that I hadn't been aware of (Edward did not do UK genealogy) and eight records later I had my grandmother's birth registration (I think it was around 100 pounds in cost for the eight records from the GRO (General Register Office of the United Kingdom) but finding it was amazing along with her baptism where her mother worked and my father was baptized at that exact same Church in Kimpton I discovered as I purchased the fiche for that particular parish (although he was born at Eastleigh)). Followed the lines that were known and they were in the letters which my grandfather had kept from those days and my parents then kept them and they had passed all of that to Edward to write the book which he remembered (as this was sixteen years later) and out came all of that box of information and I worked my way through all of it and found her. Her name was Ada Bessie Cotteril Rawlings but known as Edith Bessie (Blake) Taylor although on the census it was always Bessie Taylor (1891 and 1901) except in 1881 before her mother married WilliamTaylor she was with her grandparents who identified her as Ada Rawlings their granddaughter (one of my Rawlings cousins said that the dialects in North Wiltshire might have led to Ada sounding like Edith). I became a true believer in Ancestry as I signed up for it when I did a search very early on in my course work and discovered that they had records for Pincombe that I wanted. The pop up offered two weeks free but I just signed up for a membership and have been there ever since. It is a great service to the community for sure as are the other databases. I subscribe to all of them – Find My Past, Ancestry, and My Heritage. That is my fun so to speak but it occupies my brain as I age

without my husband whom we all miss and it is now 4.5 years since he passed away. He is always in our thoughts when new things happen and we recall oh that was his favourite. Never forgotten; his fear of being forgotten stemmed from his father appearing to have been forgotten in the small town where Edward grew up. When we bought the car; he never owned one before we were married we traveled back to his home town some Saturdays visiting the people that he had worked for and he learned a great deal about his father and he was happy about that. He followed in his footsteps enjoying gardening as his father was a farmer; he knew from his mother that his father had been an elder in the United Church and also Treasurer so he followed that too. I still remember when he found this picture he had never remembered seeing. It was at the bottom of his mother's hope chest sort of stuck in a corner and when he brought it out he was so thrilled he came to find me to show me this picture of himself in his father's arms with his mother and older brother. He would have been around one year of age in that picture. At that time our first grandson was just about the same age. My older daughter (his aunt) and Edward took all these pictures where Edward was holding his grandson just like his father had held him. It was beautiful to watch actually. COVID 19 really did take him away in some ways; he was used to going shopping at least twice a day and walking in the malls which he loved to do and I couldn't convince him that you could just walk around the house a whole lot and around the yard. Medical complications made life more difficult for his movement about and we had to say goodbye to him which saddened his daughters (and me) very much. His grandsons still miss him very much; he would have been so great with them.

There are no new members in the Blake yDNA Study. A few of the groups have independent researchers who manage them and likely you will have heard from them if you are matching them. I do not generally write to anyone as I am likely unable to aid you unless you are in one of their groups or in the group from which my Blake line descends. To me this is a collection period during which vast amounts of data are going to get organized and the methodology continues to develop as to just how we will organize this data. FT DNA does a great job with their current (and it is fairly new) y-DNA tree assigning haplogroups way into the past and up to the present to match the results that have been obtained by testing the samples. I can add very little to that other than try and organize the kits of people in this project into lines that suit the results of their data. This may not happen quickly as time needs to pass with each result whilst I look at the available data. All individuals are now assigned. I always welcome any comments from people on the assigning to a particular group. R-M269 is a particularly large group within the study and it has been broken down by an earlier researcher. I have somewhat retained the structure that Barrie Blake had because he often communicated with individuals within the group. But I do welcome any new information that might help to better refine some of these groups.

### 3. Andover, Hampshire, England, Parish Registers - Baptisms

Andover, Hampshire, England has often been said to be the "home of the Blakes" when I have been writing to people in Hampshire through the years. I would say that Calne, Wiltshire perhaps has a stronger hold on that particular title (the Blake family at Andover acquired the surname Blake sometime in the late 1200s/early 1300s and I am still determining that) although there are a number of other areas in England where the Blake family has also been for centuries. When I decided to transcribe the Parish Registers of Andover I was surprised to find that yes there are a number of Blake entries but there are far more Blake entries in Parish Registers in other parts of England as mentioned. In this issue, I will publish the baptisms for Blake and others in the Parish Registers. These records are taken from fiche which have scans of the original parish registers. The registers for baptisms begin in 1588 and have provided me with a lot of details on the Blake family in Andover in the late 1500s and into the 1600s/1700s. Eventually I may complete my project of transcribing these Parish Registers for St Marys Andover beyond the early to mid 1700s (but the online database at Find My Past is excellent as it provides the scans which you can enlarge!).

Baptismal Registers commenced in 1588 and I will publish these transcriptions for Andover.
