### **1. Blake Family of Andover, Hampshire, England**

I completed the rephasing of my grandparents DNA and surprisingly I inherited two singleton chromosomes from my father including Chromosomes 1 and 20. Chromosome 1 is the longest of the chromosomes so inheriting it intact is interesting although it includes both Blake and Knight (my great grandparents) and in the Knight line there is slight endogamy given the marriage of Ellis Knight and Eleanor Knight (likely second cousins) and my 3x great grandparents. I am now phasing my great grandparents which takes me back to the early census in England 1841 on plus the 1841 census in Upper Canada since my first Canadian born ancestor Grace Gray appears on that census. Having all of that census information and the parish information I feel confident as I move backward in time looking at Andover. I have transcribed the Parish Registers for Andover from the beginning to the mid 1700s so will likely review the period between the mid 1700s and the mid 1800s and consider transcribing them but that is a huge task. I am publishing those transcripts of the early registers in this newsletter over the next issues.

**I have not done anymore writing in the book at this time as I have spent these past six months plus on the autosomal DNA matches of myself and four of my six siblings. The results have been very interesting and pretty much exactly the same as the original phasing of my grandparents back in 2015. There were a few differences resulting from the introduction of the Living DNA results and their cross over points which were pretty close to the same as the cross over points that I gained from GedMatch and 23 and Me and comparing all of the charts of each of the testing companies – My Heritage, FT DNA, 23 and Me, Ancestry (via Gedmatch), and Living DNA.**

**The plan continues to be that I will now begin the generations chart for Andover beginning with Robert Blake who left his will in 1521 at Enham near Andover. He will initially be Generation 1 but I also have documents prior to this time relating to the Blake family of Andover and the Blake family of Berkshire (namely Speen area) and the serendipitous notion on my part that the le Blak family found at Wargrave near Windsor was the le Blake family of Rouen, Normandy who received a patent to set up a market in England in 1274. The Pipe Rolls of 1301 which includes records of Wargrave and area mention a Richard le Blak and members of his family including a daughter Alice. By the mid 1300s there is a Blake family in the records around the Andover area. The le Blak family appears to have moved south westward towards Hungerford in the early 1300s and I propose that the Blake family of Calne is descendant of this family given their position in the 1300s at Calne their being of Norman descent would have been beneficial to them I believe.**

**The notion that the Calne Blake family and the Andover Blake family are related in the male line has been discussed by me a number of times. I do not believe that they are related in the male line but thus far my proof is limited to wills in the Speen Berkshire area in the mid 1500s, records in Hampshire in the 1300s where Blake is found as a surname close to Andover. The relationship is not a close one in the wills but more of a distant cousin relationship which would be expected after two centuries. The Blake Family Pedigree held at the Swindon and Wiltshire Record office names a Richard le Blak as the progenitor of the Calne Blake family but references on that chart are inaccurate and pertain to a different le Blak family. This pedigree links the Calne Blake family with the Andover Blake family in the male line but does not stand up to scrutiny of existing wills and land records. However I have not reviewed all of the land records so requires more scrutiny. The Blake Chart held by the Blake Museum in Bridgwater, Somerset also alludes to a relationship between the Calne Blake family and the Blake family of Andover but reaches back several generations**

**earlier (and was produced later that the Pedigree Chart already mentioned). Myself I think the connection goes all the way back to Richard le Blak and relates to his daughter Alice le Blak marrying in Hampshire whomever was on the Knights Enham farm at that time. Surnames were not used in England prior to the coming of the Normans in 1066. Even by the 1200s many English people were not yet using a surname and marrying someone with a surname sounds quite logical particularly if you are an English owner of a farm and your wife to be is of Norman descent and has a surname. The logic to me is reasonable but more digging might actually prove it.**

**The yDNA of my Blake line is ancient to the British Isles, called Deer-Hunters by Ethnoancestry, and two of my brothers were tested and the results pointed back to this Western Hunter-Gatherer. The best match to them has stated Dublin, Ireland as his location. That was rather interesting given the state of the British Isles 8,000 to 12,000 years ago when the British Isles was once again free of ice and inhabitable. Small groups of wandering Western Hunter Gatherers were certainly all over the northern European areas in this time frame. The Blood of the Isles database certainly sees the haplogroup of my brothers as one of those early yDNA lines in the British Isles.**

**Along with that my grandfather's stories of his family as being ancient to the British Isles and in particular he did stress the Andover area. Glancing at yDNA results in my brother's haplogroup there are a number of local families with equally long history in this area of northern Hampshire. This area of Hampshire by my own viewing is a beautiful moderate climate area where the herds would likely have been found and that was the source of the Western Hunter Gatherer migrations towards the north of the Eurasian Continent as they wandered further and further north and west after the Ice Age. It wasn't until we started to hear more of the stories of the First Peoples here that I realized that they were speaking about their familial history in a similar manner to the way in which my grandfather had discussed his family being in the Andover area. At first I thought it was just coincidental but gradually as I learned more about the First Nations I realized that a people who have lived for a very long time in an area speak that way about the area because the methodology in learning certainly even up to my early days in school was by "rote" and hence the stories were handed down generation after generation to the children of each generation to pass on to their children/grandchildren. My grandfather would repeat those stories so many times but I was a very young child (only just eight years of age when he died) and he was ensuring that one of his known six grandchildren would pass on his stories. I have not failed**

**him after all. My interest in history did exist but certainly Science was the great attraction for me as a child. It was the use of DNA in genealogy that caught my attention finally along with my third cousin (we are related because our first born Canadian ancestors in the Gray family were first cousins) who wanted me to write a profile of one of my families for his book on the History of Westminster Township, Middlesex County, Ontario although it was Upper Canada rather than Ontario when my family of interest arrived from England.**

**Recently, and this has nothing to do with the Blake Family of Andover but is interesting with regard to the Blake Family Study at FT DNA, I had an email from a descendant of the Mayo Blake family asking if I had any information on that line. Indeed I do not particularly but their closeness to the Blake family of Galway is interesting. The Galway Blake family is a huge family coming down through the centuries and written up by Martin J Blake (published in London, England) in 1902 and 1903 as two volumes. Volume 1 begins around 1300 through to 1599 and Volume 2 records the years from 1600 to 1700. The books are available on Archive.org**

**(<https://archive.org/details/blakefamilyrecor00blakuft/blakefamilyrecor00blakuft/page/n1/mode/2up> ). There are many descendants of this family and the yDNA study at FT DNA for the Blake family has a number of testers who can trace back into this Galway Blake family. Members of this family are found in many places in Ireland and in England throughout history coming down from the original Blake family at Galway. Along with a couple of comments I mentioned that the best way to look at your own Blake line is to have a male descendant in your Blake line test their yDNA. There are a number of founding lines for Blake in the British Isles and many of them can be found in the record of the Calendar of Patent Rolls. I extracted the Blake records from this set of documents when they were loaned to a researcher at the University of Iowa and I did build a chart showing frequency of Blake in the various counties of England as that was primarily the focus of my research at the time. I did take on the Blake study at the Guild of one-name Studies in 2011 when it was left vacant by Paul Blake who had been the main researcher for Blake for many years in the British Isles as a member of the Guild. So my answer said all of what is above (briefly) and to consider that the Blake line at Mayo could be an offshoot of Galway even if the furtherest back known in their line was a British military officer in Mayo during the 1600s when Cromwell was the head of government in England. Her thought was that her ancestor was descendant of the Blake family of Somerset (related to Lord High Admiral Robert Blake). I think she wondered if we shared Blake ancestry but my grandfather was always quite sure that we were not related to the Calne Blake family or the Somerset**

**Blake family in the male Blake line. Interesting he thought that but people thought differently and learned differently in the late 1800s with rote being the prime method of learning.**

**That means to me that your family stories were passed on by word of mouth generation after generation and that was why Nicholas Blake of Knights Enham, Andover, Hampshire, England was discussed in the latter part of the 1800s even though he was just a small farmer at Knights Enham who left his will in 1547. It was this Nicholas who was given all sorts of different relations that created a stir at that time in America amongst Blake families there. An American, Horatio Gates Somerby, had created a story about this time period using Nicholas, giving him incorrect parents and siblings although some of the material was correct but mostly incorrect. Amazing that there would be such a discussion 350 years later after Nicholas' death but it was this style of learning that brought forward in people's minds the details of their lives lived generation after generation and caused a rejection by those who were in the know labeling Horatio Gates Somerby as a fraud who simply engineered stories in order to impress his American clients.**

**But back to the email that I received and the incidence of Blake family at Mayo, the founder of the Blake family of Galway was Richard Caddell (Welsh and also known as Richard Niger) who used the surname Blake after receiving land grants at Galway and Mayo having accompanied then Prince John (later King John) to Ireland in 1185. The email was interesting since the Blake family of Galway was also at Mayo in the 1100s/1200s. But I do not do family research for individuals; I simply tell them what I do know and leave it up to them to do the research back in their lines.**

**I continue to be amazed at the Blake autosomal matches that I have with individuals in the present coming down from early Colonials in the American colonies. There are distinct lengths that fall into the pile-up or common areas of the chromosomes implying quite distant relationships but the size of the matches is sometimes rather surprising and one gets a notation of sixth cousin or even closer on occasion and I know very well that is not the case. The only Blake known to me that early in the American Colonies was Joanne Blake (daughter of William Blake and Dorothy Madgwick) who married Major General Robert Sedgewicke 6 Jan 1634 at Andover and their children all appeared to be born at Charlestown, Royal Colony of Massachusetts in the 1630s/1640s. Joanne herself returned to England after the death of her husband in Jamaica but their five children remained in the colonies.**

**So my quest to complete this book in 2028 continues and I will share the path with this Newsletter.**

**There is one new member in the group and he will be in I-M253 (I am getting an error when I try to work in the Member Subgrouping so will do that later). A few of the groups have independent researchers who manage them and likely you will have heard from them if you are matching them. I do not generally write to anyone as I am likely unable to aid you unless you are in one of their groups or in the group from which my Blake line descends. To me this is a collection period during which vast amounts of data are going to get organized and the methodology continues to develop as to just how we will organize this data. FT DNA does a great job with their current (and it is fairly new) y-DNA tree assigning haplogroups way into the past and up to the present to match the results that have been obtained by testing the samples. I can add very little to that other than try and organize the kits of people in this project into lines that suit the results of their data. This may not happen quickly as time needs to pass with each result whilst I look at the available data. I always welcome any comments from people on the assigning to a particular group. R-M269 is a particularly large group within the study and it has been broken down by an earlier researcher. I have somewhat retained the structure that Barrie Blake had because he often communicated with individuals within the group. But I do welcome any new information that might help to better refine some of these groups.**

### **3. Andover, Hampshire, England, Parish Registers - Baptisms**

**Andover, Hampshire, England has often been said to be the “home of the Blakes” when I have been writing to people in Hampshire through the years. I would say that Calne, Wiltshire perhaps has a stronger hold on that particular title (the Blake family at Andover acquired the surname Blake sometime in the late 1200s/early 1300s and I am still determining that) although there are a number of other areas in England where the Blake family has also been for centuries. When I decided to transcribe the Parish Registers of Andover I was surprised to find that yes there are a number of Blake entries but there are far more Blake entries in Parish Registers in other parts of England as mentioned. In this issue, I will publish the baptisms for Blake and others in the Parish Registers. These records are taken from fiche which have scans of the original parish registers. The registers for baptisms begin in 1588 and have provided me with a lot of details on the Blake family in Andover in the late 1500s and into the 1600s/1700s. Eventually I may complete my project of transcribing these Parish Registers for St Marys Andover beyond the early to mid 1700s (but the online database at Find My Past is excellent as it provides the scans which you can enlarge!).**

**Baptismal Registers commenced in 1588 and I will publish these transcriptions for Andover.**
