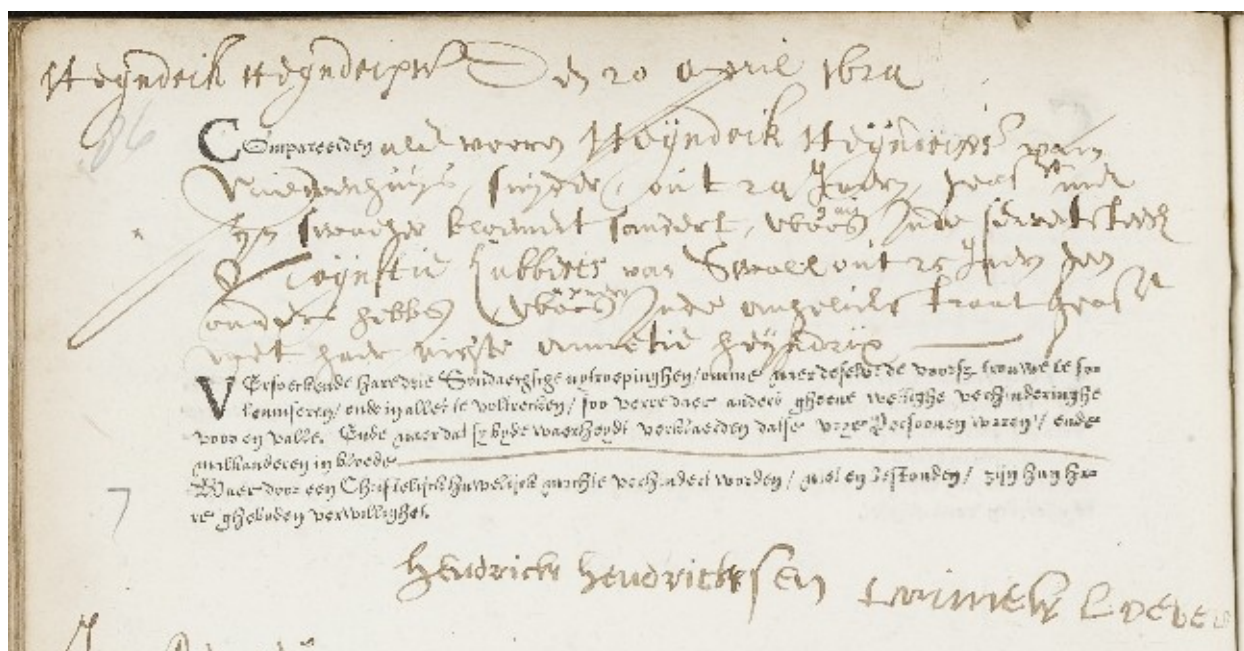


On 20 April 1624 Hendrick Hendricksz [KIP] and Tryntje Lubberts announced their marriage intentions in Amsterdam.



This is what the record says:

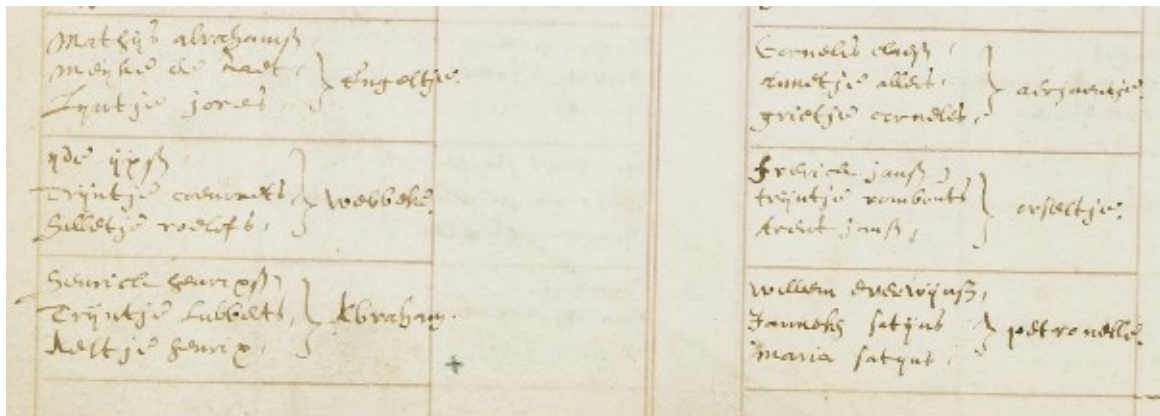

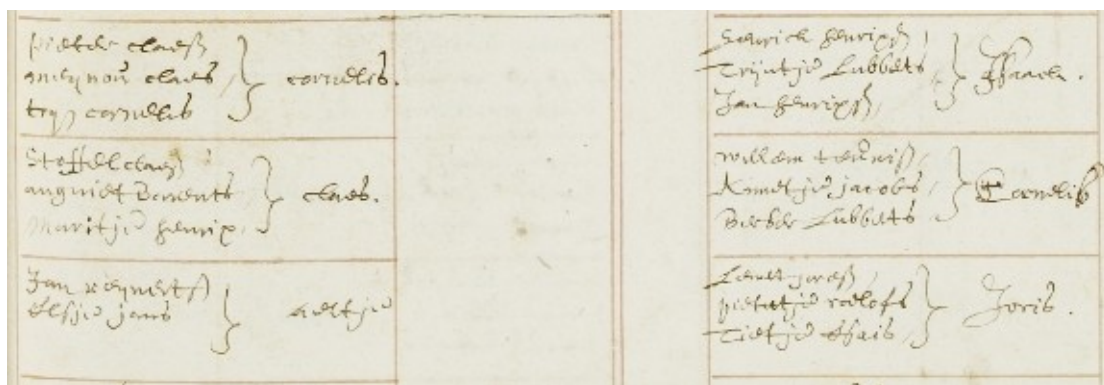
They had at least six children:

1. Abraham, baptized 6 May 1625 in the Nieuwe Kerk in Amsterdam. DTB 040p302



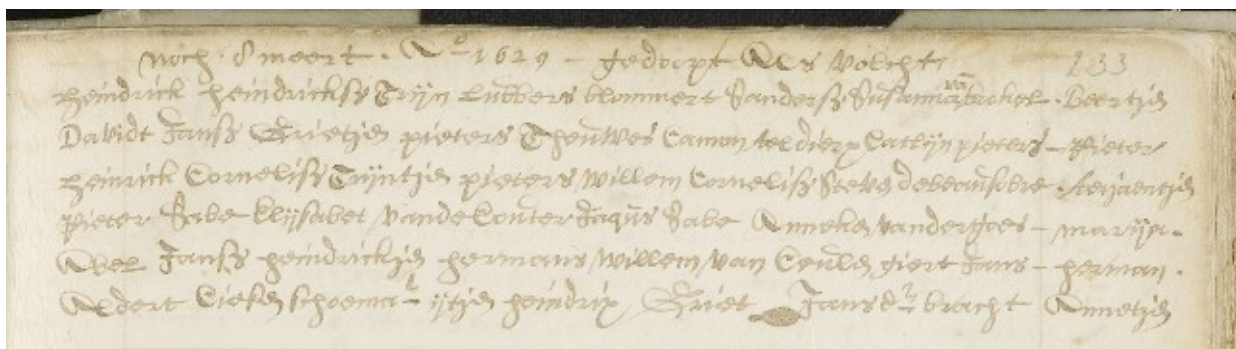
On the bottom left is the baptism of Abraham. Sponsor is Aeltje Henrix, his aunt, the sister of Hendrick Hendricksz. Abraham probably died young.

2. Isaac, baptized 10 January 1627 in the Nieuwe Kerk in Amsterdam. DTB 040p377



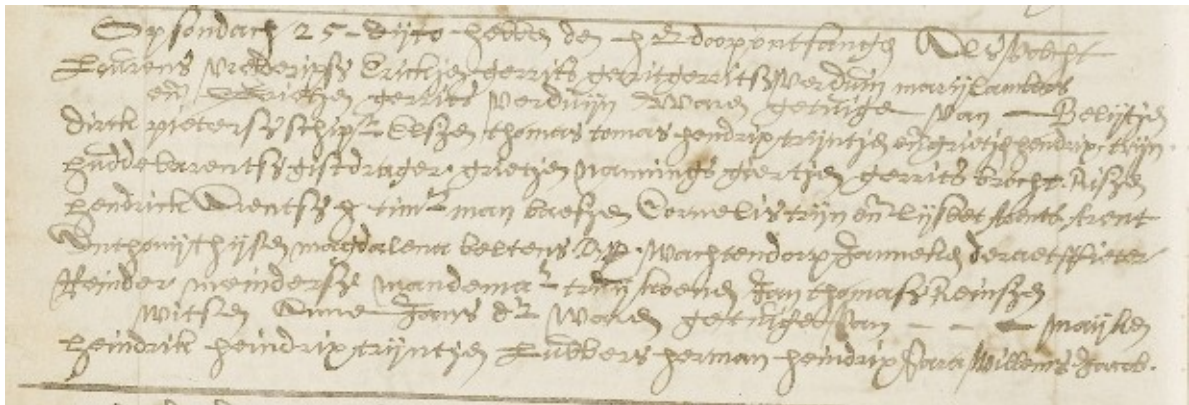
On the top right is the baptism of Isaac. Sponsor in Jan Henrixsz. probably a brother of Hendrick Hendricksz.

3. Beertje, baptized 8 March 1629 in the Oude Kerk in Amsterdam. DTB 006p233



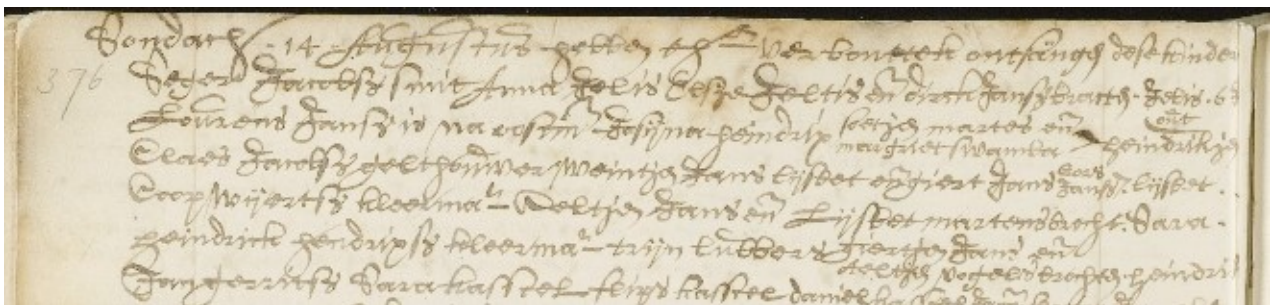
The first entry is the baptism of Beertje. Sponsors are Blommert Sanders, her uncle and Susanna van de Brokel, unknown.

4. Jacob, baptized 25 May 1631 in the Oude Kerk in Amsterdam. DTB 006p306



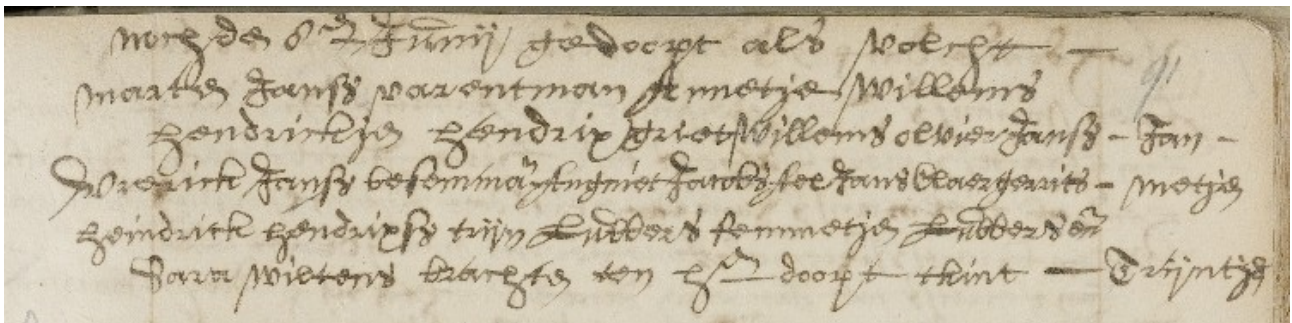
The last entry is the baptism of Jacob. Sponsors are Herman Heynrix, probably another brother of Hendrick Hendricksz and Sara Willems, unknown.

5. Hendrick, baptized 14 August 1633 in the Oude Kerk in Amsterdam. DTB 006p376



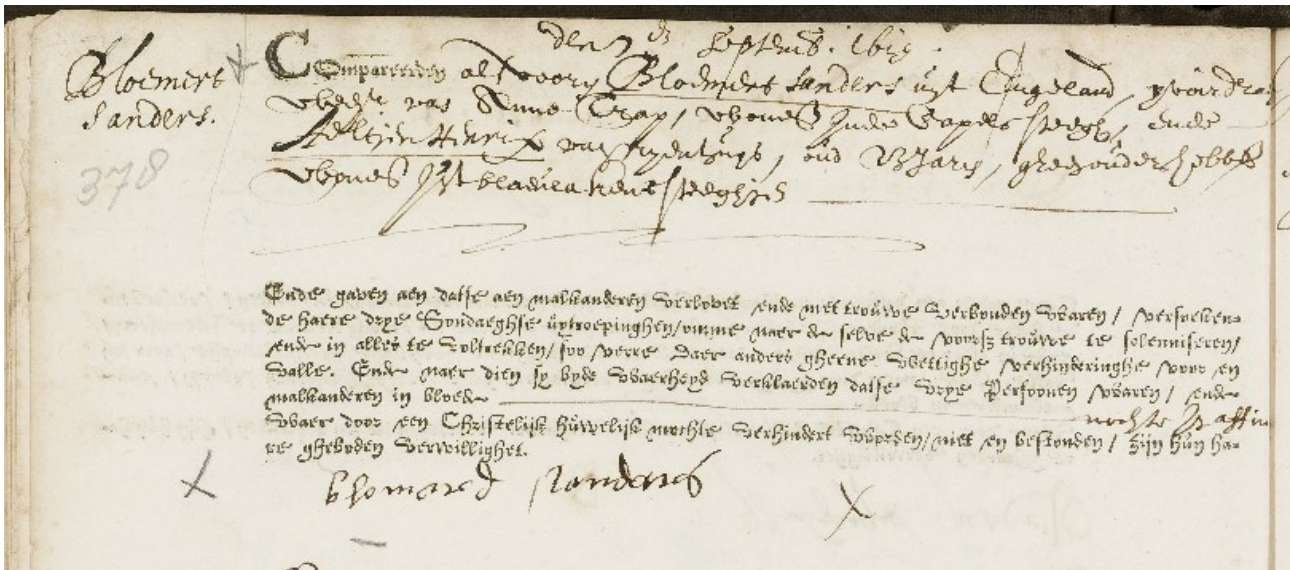
The last (readable) entry is the baptism of Hendrick. Sponsors are Giertje Jans and Aeltje Vogels, both unknown.

6. Tryntje, baptized 8 June 1636 in the Oude Kerk in Amsterdam. DTB 007p091



The last entry is the baptism of Tryntje. Sponsors are Femmetje Lubbers, probably a sister of the mother and Sara Wiltens. The text after her name is: brachten ten hare doop tkint Tryntje, meaning they brought in the child.

The assistant at the marriage of Hendrick and Tryntje was his brother-in-law Blommert Sanders, who married Aeltje Hendricks. They announced their marriage intentions on 7 September 1619.

2. Alexander, baptized 5 December 1624 in the Oude Kerk in Amsterdam. DTB 006p101
Sponsor is Tryntje Lubberts, wife of Hendrick Hendricksz
3. Isabella, baptized 5 June 1629 in the Oude Kerk in Amsterdam. DTB 006p241
Sponsor is Tryntje Lubberts, wife of Hendrick Hendricksz
