
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1. Pincombe Charts, original One-Name Study at the Guild of One-Name Studies These Pincombe Charts were created by the two researchers in the original One-name-study at

the Guild of one-name-studies. I reprint them with the thought in mind that others could add to the knowledge of these charts. I have reworked some of them and will publish that information when complete. I am publishing Chart 14 – United States of America in this issue. This is a Chart that Galen Pinkham and Richard Pinkham produced. I have not done any work on it at all. I have corresponded with a number of Pinkham/Pincomb/Pincombe families in the United States but other than my own line that went to Kansas (a brother of my 2x great grandfather Robert Pincomb) I do not have very much information on the family in the United States other than the descendants of Robert Pincomb who arrived in 1835.

There are at least two published books that mention Richard Pinkham who came to Dover, New Hampshire Colony and died there between 1671 and 5 May 1688. He was thought to have been born in England circa 1613. The New Hampshire Genealogical Record Vol 22, pages 1-7, 63-67, 115-25 and 164-71 may have information listed on Richard Pinkham and the comment in this particular book is that this work will be continued in the 2006 volume (multi-generational work concentrating on descendants of John 2). This particular book entitled: New "Englanders in the 1600s : A Guide to Genealogical Research Published Between 1980 and 2005, Martin E Hollick. Published by the New England Historic Genealogical Society.

A search of the NEHGS site (my husband is a member) revealed an extract from Dover Town Records including The Tax List, for 1653 and noting that Rich: pincham was a freeman. Torrey's New England Marriages includes this record for Richard Pinkham (1613 -) and Julia Jellia Gyliam by 1643 Dover, NH. An Extract from Old Town Records of Dover, NH (communicated by George T Wentworth, Esquire): 27th of the 9th month, 1648 – It is this day ordered at a publique Towne meeting that Richard Pinkham shall beate the drumme on Lord's days to give notice for the time of meeting and to sweepe the meeting house for the which hee shall bee allowed six bushels of Indian corn for his pay this yeare and to bee freed from rates.

Perhaps the most interesting item in the search was from a work: Genealogical Items Relating to the Early Settlers of Dover, N.H. (communicated by Mr Alonzo H Quint, M.N.E.H.G.S.). This particular item published in 1853 and commencing on page 353.

PINKHAM, Richard. Regarding the PINKHAM family, tradition tells, of course of the "three brothers who came over." One, it says, settled on Dover Neck, one at Oyster River and one on Bloody Point side, - a tradition which is entirely without foundation. Perhaps the family story which says that the Isle of Wight was its former residence may be entitled to more credit. It is certain however that Richard PINKHAM, the first ancestor of the name who "came over," the gentleman who was ordered by a vote of the town in 1648, to "beat the drumme" on Lord's day to call the people to meeting, was here too in 1642 and perhaps earlier. The spot where he early dwelt is said to be the same on which stood the Pinkham garrison which Richard afterwards made his habitation. On Dover neck is a house now occupied by Elijah Pinkham, a man of more than eighty years, who owns land once owned by his ancestor Richard. About four rods directly west of this house was the garrison house, half of which was taken down about two years after the wind had demolished the other half, viz., about 1825.

Richard lived on Dover Neck and died there. He appears to have been a man of good character and had his share of public office. He 1671 he conveyed the bulk of his property to his son John, who engaged to support him.



Of the children of Richard we know the names of but three: Richard, John and Thomas (who was taxed on Dover Neck 1667 and 8 and then vanishes). [This continues on looking at the children of Richard PINKHAM the emigrant.]

The Great Migration Directory: Immigrants to New England, 1620-1640 and compiled by Robert Charles Anderson, FASG also mentions Richard Pinkham. Unknown place of origin, arrived in 1640, Dover (NHPP (Provincial Papers, Documents and Records relating to the Province of New Hampshire from 1686 to 1722, 40 volumes, Nathaniel Boulton, ed. (Manchester, NH 1867-1943)) 1:128, 10:701; GDMNH (Sybil Noyes, Charles Thornton Libby and Walter Goodwin Davis, Genealogical Dictionary of Maine and New Hampshire (Portland, Maine, 1928-1939; rpt. Baltimore 1972)) 557; NHGR 22:1-3).

At a later date I will redraw these charts with all the new information that I have acquired and they will be electronic. It is perhaps a challenge that I should take on with the Pincombe project and will consider what other elements I want to pass on to another researcher when I step down. As well I will give copies to both the Guild of one-name Studies and the Society of Genealogists. I continue as a member of both groups.

These tables represent many years of work at the record offices by the two original Pincombe-Pinkham family researchers and Richard Pinkham was a physician and able to make contact with



some of the Pincombe families living in Devon. The names seen on these charts usually in the top corners are individuals who provided information for that particular chart. In the case of charts from the United States, Galen Pinkham has contributed a great deal of information to the descendants of the Pincombe/Pinkham family and this information can be found on the charts which he produced. I do remind other researchers that there are discrepancies in these charts and I would appreciate knowing of any that you may find so that eventually a corrected chart will be published.

This is the will of my 3x great uncle William Pincombe, the second eldest son of John Pincombe and Mary Charlie/Charley. William Pincombe and his wife Mary (unknown). I have not yet found a marriage for this couple. They baptized seven children (all except the last at Bishops Nympton).

John Pincombe baptized 26 Dec 1798 and buried 22 Jul 1830 Bishops Nympton Mary Pincombe baptized 31 Mar 1800 and married William Matthews 1 Jul 1818 Bishops Nympton William Pincombe baptized 1 Jan 1802 and married Maria Torrington 15 May 1822 Bishops Nympton

Johannah Pincombe baptized 16 Oct 1803 and buried 14 Feb 1805 Bishops Nympton Emmanuel Pincombe baptized 1 Jan 1805 and buried 13 Apr 1806 Bishops Nympton Anna Pincombe baptized 14 Oct 1806 and married John Hole 28 Feb 1828 Bishops Nympton Catherine Pincombe baptized 24 Jan 1813 at Tiverton and likely deceased by 1838



3. North Molton Parish Records

These baptismal records are transcribed from the fiche of the original Parish Records for North Molton, Devon. I have changed the orientation of the newsletter to make it easier to publish the transcriptions for North Molton directly from my Excel file.
