1. **Discussion: The Book and deciding on a few items**

First of all the title of the book. The study has been called Pincombe-Pinkham as selected by the two earlier researchers Galen Pinkham and Dr Richard Pinkham. I am not sure how long Galen was researching but I think rather a long time but I know that Dr Richard Pinkham was collecting information in his travels in Devon as early as the 1930s and continued until he stopped practising Family Medicine and until his eyesight was no longer able to manage the documents. He had sent some material to another researcher, Richard Phillips, and he forwarded on to me a number of items which had been given to him by Dr Richard Pinkham. Richard is descendant of the Pincombe/Pinkham family at Northlew. I am convinced that this family is descendant of one of the families that was at South Molton. There is both family lore and actual records linking the families at South Molton and Bideford/Barnstaple/Northlew. The time period is a bit elusive but definitely well before 1800. So I have this material in my possession from all of these earlier researchers who tended to use either Pincombe or Pinkham or both hyphenated when they worked on this project. In my line at Bishops Nympton the spelling was always Pincomb and sometimes with the e on the end. Richard Pincomb is first found there in the 1599 Parish Register baptizing his son William with an earlier reference to his daughter Anne who was buried in 1598. His first wife Anne died possibly when William was



born and he married a second time in 1603 Frances Gil at Bishops Nympton.

The first item is naming of this Pincombe family book and they were located at North Molton and the Visitation of Devon 1620 notes that a Pyncombe arrived at North Molton early in the reign of Henry VII with Lord de la Zouch. The only other location that I have found that early for a “Pyncombe” family is the Pencombe family of Herefordshire (and the spelling of Pencombe was used by the early descendants of Pyncombe. I am thinking of naming the book The Pencombe family of Herefordshire and Devon but I am not fixed on it yet. I will continue to consider it as I review the old documents.

A second item that I want to think about is the style of the book. The one that I am finally in the process of finishing up has twelve generations of the family from the 1500s to the 1920s along with quite a bit of historical detail. In total the 12 chapters on the generations and another six chapters on other items. The first documents for the Pencombe family are in the early 1300s but the actual material available is limited although I am still in the initial stages of looking at that material. I have not yet looked at the Archives in Herefordshire. I do not plan to go there at 78 years of age for sure but I can order anything that I might feel is worthwhile helping me to better understand this family. But the Siderfin family (my current project) is considerably smaller than the Pencombe family and its many derivatives probably as much as 1/10th the size of the family or less probably less even than 10%.

A third item will be a chapter on autosomal DNA as I have many cousins who have tested their autosomal DNA at all the different companies. Four of my six siblings have tested (plus myself) at all of the major companies so the list of matches is quite extensive. I believe I can share particular lengths that are common to Pincombe in North Devon.

A fourth item is mapping which I would like to do as the Pincombe-Pinkham families have traveled all over the world. Using maps I can demonstrate that without revealing any particular individuals.

A fifth item is how many generations to do from the earliest that I can get back to. Definitely it would be a plus to do the generations down to the beginning of Census in England and Wales (a number of Pincombe families did move to Wales). But



that would definitely be a huge task. It would perhaps be a goal that I might set and then I just move along forward one generation at a time. I could also have a marker with the Parish Registers when they came into really common and fully recorded by the population which would be the late 1600s with the return of King Charles II to England. I think I will set my goals as firstly to the latter part of the 1600s and the second to the middle of the 1800s. Then somewhere between the beginning and the census would be where I would stop. That is perhaps one of the gains in working on the Pincombe and the Blake families of my parents in tandem. I will have the same questions working with the Blake family of Andover which is equally large. I think perhaps compatible to Pincombe in size since I would not include the Blake family at Calne which is likely 30 to 50 times as large as the Andover family and likely includes the Somerset and perhaps even the Devon lines. The Cornwall Blake is I believe a mixture of newer Breton immigrants in the early 1500s and a crossover from Devon. But the Breton people could simply have been a group that lived between these two areas for centuries; that is pretty difficult to determine. I did do some work on it earlier but I digress from Pincombe.

2. DNA and its value in the study

Perhaps it is because I am female but I do not attach as much importance to the y-DNA as some people looking at families. In at least one will for Pincombe the line is created because a sister's son took on his uncle's surname to inherit the property. Hence the yDNA of that line will likely be different because this son carries his father's y-DNA and his mother's Pincombe mt-DNA. There are also Non paternal events or daughter's lines where the surname that the infant has is that of the mother and in this generation some people do use their mother's surname. The y-DNA is interesting mostly for its historical markers showing ethnicity in my opinion then it is for proof of family line.



On the other hand, mitochondrial DNA only shows one's ancient mother to mother to mother on into the ages and that surname until recently changed with each generation. In essence women lost their birth-right by having to take another surname mostly by custom but that custom was really the law in those times. I found mitochondrial DNA fascinating because it also took me back to an ancient time in the British Isles in Argyllshire/Ayrshire according to Bryan Syke's Blood of the Isles Database. Quite fascinating really as having that in mind I did find members who match us coming down from Scotland into northern England during the 1700s/1800s and also matches going from Scotland to Northern Ireland during the Cromwell era as "Planters" and this particular line went to the Carolinas in the 1770s taking the mitochondrial DNA with them and that line can be traced as it moved across the Continent to Texas and other places west of the Carolinas. So it can be a fascinating story as well.

But it is the autosomal DNA that is most interesting as one matches one's cousins. I do not have any first cousins, my second cousin's on my mother's side are all half cousins. On my father's side I have full second cousins on his father's side and half-second cousins on his mother's side. But so much can be learned because on my paternal grandfather's side he has collapsing pedigree in his lines making those matches quite large for third cousins/fourth cousins. On my mother's paternal side she too has collapsing pedigree in her Routledge line also making those matches larger than normal but they generally are fourth cousins/fifth cousins and even some sixth share enough to be a surprise. So looking at autosomal will certainly happen with this book on the Pencombe family as well. Perhaps not a great deal on the y-DNA unless I name all of the lines because I do not know all the histories and so all belong because of their surnames. The mitochondrial is more of a challenge but if the opportunity presents itself I may look at some of them. This is an English family predominantly from south western England from the 1480s on and possibly from the Midlands as mentioned above and there one would be looking at hundreds of years at least and possibly a couple of thousand as there were a number of waves of Celtic immigration to the British Isles.



3. Landkey Parish Records

These burial records are transcribed from the fiche of the original Parish Records for Landkey, Devon. I have changed the orientation of the newsletter to make it easier to publish the transcriptions for Landkey directly from my Excel file. This begins the burials. I only purchased the Parish Records into the early to mid 1700s so these records do not extend past that date.
