
# **Pincombe-Pinkham Newsletter**

- 1. Discussion: The Book

The title of the book is "The History of the Pencombe Family of North Molton, Devonshire, England" at this time. I am into it now with 39 pages completed although I am still revising/re-examining some of my writing thus far. I am not bogged down yet; I am in the chapter thus far titled "The de Pencombe family in Herefordshire." The front page has the Coat of Arms which was issued to John Pyncombe of South Molton in 1616.

I may need to ask permission of the College of Arms to use this Coat of Arms in the book although the distribution will be the same as the Siderfin book that I completed in January 2024 (one of my Pincombe lines married the daughter of a female Siderfin descendant line) and freely available on my website and from any library that wishes to have a copy in their digital holdings. The plan is that all of my books will be free (it is my amusement in my old age so any costs are just part of that fun!).

The Inquisition Postmorten appears in British History online that I purchased from the Archives of the United Kingdom but I wanted to see the full document (not that my Latin is any better than the person who prepared the translation) but I wondered if any little items were omitted.

# **524. JOHN PENCOMBE, or DE PENCOMBE.\***

Writ to the escheator to enquire as to the lands &c. held by the said John of the bishopric of Hereford and of others, the name and age of his heir, and who has been in possession of his lands since his death and received the issues. 10 July, 37 Edward III.

HEREFORD. Ing. taken at Bromeyerd, 10 September, 37 Edward III.

Bromyerd Foreyn. 12a. land, held of the bishopric of Hereford, lately vacant and in the king's hand, by knight's service and by payment to the bishop of 6d. an acre; and a messuage and a carucate of land, held in socage.

He held no lands &c. except of the bishopric. He died on 13 November, 35 Edward III, about noon. Thomas his son, aged 14 1/2 years, is his heir. Robert, vicar of the church of Bromyerd, has been in possession of the premises since his death and received the issues thereof, by what title the jurors cannot say. (Underwritten.) Let a commitment thereof be made to Stephen de Eyncheton, (paying) for the wardship the extent, and for the marriage 20s.

As mentioned in the last newsletter (1 December 2023, Volume 9, Issue 1) the study has been called Pincombe-Pinkham as selected by the two earlier researchers Galen Pinkham and Dr Richard Pinkham. I am not sure how long Galen was researching but I think rather a long time but I know that Dr Richard Pinkham was collecting information in his travels in Devon as early as the 1930s and continued until he stopped practising Family Medicine and until his eyesight was no longer able to manage the documents. He had sent some material to another researcher, Richard Phillips, and he forwarded on to me a number of items which had been given to him by Dr Richard Pinkham. Richard is descendant of the Pincombe/Pinkham family at Northlew. I am convinced that this family is descendant of one of the families that was at South Molton. There is both family lore and actual records linking the families at South Molton and Bideford/Barnstaple/Northlew. The time period is a bit elusive but definitely well before 1800. So I have this material in my possession from all of these earlier researchers who tended to use either Pincombe or Pinkham or both hyphenated when they worked on this project. In my line at Bishops Nympton the spelling was always Pincomb and sometimes with the e on the end. Richard Pincomb is first found there in the 1599 Parish Register baptizing his son William with an earlier reference to his daughter Anne who was buried in 1598. His first wife Anne died possibly when William was born and he married a second time in 1603 Frances Gil at Bishops Nympton.

My line appears to be at Bishops Nympton the entire period from 1599 to the 1900s. I do not know if there are any direct descendants of John Pincomb and Mary (Charly) Pincomb now living in Bishops Nympton. My line coming down from their third son Robert and Elizabeth (Rowcliffe) Pincomb did not remain in Bishops Nympton. Of their eight children, one son William died young, Richard and Philip the youngest children remained in England with Richard locating in Birmingham until he retired to Somerset and Philip living in Somerset. The eldest son Robert emigrated to the United States in 1835, the next emigrant was John and Elizabeth (Rew) Pincombe and their five children in 1850/51 through the Port of New York and joining Robert in Genessee New York where he lived at that time but they went on to Upper Canada (London area), Elizabeth (second child and only daughter) married Richard Elworthy in England and they emigrated to Canada in 1855 and Thomas the next child after John was emigrating to Canada departing May 1855 but the entire family died (3 May 1855) when their ship floundered off the coast of England. George the next eldest had married Ann Woolway 9 Sep 1843 at Tiverton, Devon and he and his wife moved to London where they lived for a few years. George emigrated to Australia with the intent of bringing his family there once he was established but his wife refused to go to Australia and the five children (one died in infancy)



remained in London. George remained in Australia although his siblings had tried to persuade him to come to Canada before he went to Australia. The family coming down from John Pincombe and Mary (Charly) Pincomb was quite large with six children and thirty four grandchildren (although the seven children of Thomas were lost at sea sadly).

I had discussed the style of the book in the last newsletter as well. The Siderfin Book (it will also soon be available on the Family Search Digital Library (I had a note back thanking me for donating the book (the book is free by the way on my website, on my blog or you can write to me if you do not find it) that I completed has twelve generations of the family from the 1500s to 1920 (with a couple of exceptions). How far will I bring this book to in terms of present day – I think my cutoff will likely be 1900 at the latest but the book would start as early as 1100 apparently due to the recent record that I located. So we are perhaps looking at 16 generations or more if I am actually able to obtain all of that data. The first documents for the Pencombe family are in the early 1100s during the time of Henry I which might coincide with the arrival of this family in England. I had thought they were perhaps earlier as part of a Celtic migration but the latest find has them being descendent of a Flanders individual who surname I have not yet located. but the actual material available is limited although I am still in the initial stages of looking at that material. The Pencombe family is much larger overall at first glance but there are generations where there were few children.

The chapter on autosomal DNA remains of great interest but I have already written a chapter on the yDNA of the line from which I descend. There are three members of the exact same result for the Y-700 test at FT DNA. Although I have written the chapter it is still in process so will not say much further on the yDNA chapter. Should I include the results for the members of the Pinkham family (all members of the testing group are from the United States)? I have not yet made a decision on that actually. Initially the plan was to include all members of the Pincombe-Pinkham yDNA study but as the process slowly unfolds I am unsure but will, over the next year come up with a decision.

There will also be a chapter with emigration marking. The Pincombe-Pinkham families are located all over the world but tend to be in Commonwealth countries and the United States of America.



That is a good start on what I plan for the book and of course any suggestions are most welcomed from readers (email: kippeeb@rogers.com). The Siderfin book is mostly of interest to those who descend from John Pincombe and Elizabeth (Rew) Pincombe as Elizabeth (Siderfin) Rew was the mother of Elizabeth (Rew) Pincombe.

# 2. DNA and its value in the study

It is the autosomal DNA that is most interesting in terms of whole family as one matches one's cousins. The comparisons are quite interesting using the autosomal DNA and I have 80 Pincombe cousins on 23 and Me, 21 on FT DNA, 63 on Gedmatch from Ancestry, and 64 on My Heritage. For some there is overlap but overall a good selection of inherited Pincombe DNA in cousins compared to that inherited by myself or my four siblings to actually let me build my mother's DNA inherited from her father separating it into the DNA inherited that was Pincombe and the DNA inherited from her mother. Personally I think that is the greatest value in DNA when one looks at family lines. In terms of deep ancestry, of course, the yDNA provides the most information.

When this study was created by Galen Pinkham and Dr Richard Pinkham the two surnames were chosen – Pincombe and Pinkham. Both surnames are used within the Pincombe family that descended from North Molton but I only have seen Pinkham used by the family descendant from the emigrant Richard Pinkham who arrived in the Royal Colony of New Hampshire in the early 1640s. His parents are named as Richard Pincombe and Marye Russell who married 25 July 1613 in the Alwington Parish Registers (Find My Past). A son Richard Pincomb was baptized 7 Nov 1613 in the Alwington Parish Registers. Going to the Bideford Chart producted by the earlier researchers, I find that Richard married to Mary Russel is listed as the son of Phillipe Pyncombe and Wilmote Beare. There is a will for a Philip Pyncombe probated 1632 but the original was lost in the bombing of the Devon Record Office. The 1543 Devon Lay Subsidy lists a Beare family at Alwington but no Pincombe family there at that time. However there is a Philip Pynkeham at Tawstock. The distance between the two



is 13.6 miles or 21.9 kilometres (by a current road). Philip is said to be a son of William Pincombe of Bideford on the chart. There is a Richard Pencombe at Bideford on the 1543 Devon Lay Subsidy. The William who heads up this chart has four children listed: William, Phillipe, Johane and Richard. Who is this William? His children are born in the 1560s according to the Chart. So perhaps he is born around the 1530s (pre Parish Registers perhaps). On the 1524-1527 Lay Subsidy of Devon we have the following list:

The names marked in red correspond to the Visitation of Devon 1620 members of this family who likely existed in 1624-27. There is a William at North Molton and there are three children baptized by William and his wife Elizabeth (two girls and a boy William that is buried as a child). Thomas does have a son William but this William left a will naming his children and that will has survived. How to solve the mystery? Having committed myself to the book do I now limit it solely to my know family line coming down from



North Molton which is basically everyone above. It is a conundrum because I want to continue to respect the work done by the earlier researchers. The yDNA not matching with the Pinkham group in the study can be thought through because it was not unusual for a sister'\s child to take on an uncle's surname and inherit his property. I will continue to think about this in terms of the study. Especially having now found that the yDNA of this Pencombe line may actually be from Flanders and have arrived post-Conquest. Two of the Pinkham members in the study have completed the Y-700 test. Until I decided to write the book I was mostly a bystander just watching as the results flowed into the study. I am a bit inclined to be more of a watcher than a decider but I think that I must start to reconcile some of these ideas with the writings that have been produced for the American Pinkham family. The Pincombe family from which I descend has not had a book produced until the present rendition that I am in the process of creating. More discussion in the next newsletter on the y-DNA.

## 3. Landkey Parish Records

These burial records are transcribed from the fiche of the original Parish Records for Landkey, Devon. I have changed the orientation of the newsletter to make it easier to publish the transcriptions for Landkey directly from my Excel file. I only purchased the Parish Records into the early to mid 1700s so these records do not extend past that date.
